NOTICE- Community Garden Program Lottery

Dear Valued Residents:

Stanford West Apartments Community Garden Program (“The Veggie Garden”) has become a popular amenity for our residents. The program provides an opportunity to participate in its 100% organic garden by auctioning off 41 small garden plots each year. The plots are located on the median divider of Clark Way between Charles Marx Way and Mosher Way. In these plots, only organic materials can be used and pesticides, herbicides, chemical fertilizers, or chemically treated wood products are strictly prohibited.

If you are interested in the Veggie Garden Program, we will be conducting a new lottery drawing for these plots in the Leasing Office on Saturday, April 20th, 1:00 pm.

In an effort to include more interested residents than previous years, residents no longer need to be present during the lottery to win. Interested residents who are unable to attend the day of drawing may pick up a raffle ticket from the Leasing Office, beginning Monday, April 1st through end of business day Friday, April 19th. Attending residents will be handed tickets just before the drawing.

Upon winning, a Community Garden Agreement must be signed and a watering key will be provided to you. If a winner is not present at the time of the lottery, the agreement will be emailed and must be returned to the Leasing Office within 48 hours. If the agreement is not returned within 48 hours, the garden plot will be forfeited and another winner will be selected from a waiting list. The term of the agreement is for approximately one year starting April 20, 2019 and ending March 31, 2020 at which time another lottery will be held. During the term of the agreement plot holders are responsible for the maintenance and tidiness of their garden plots.

We’re looking forward to seeing many garden enthusiasts at the lottery drawing.

If you currently have a reserved garden plot, please return your watering key by Monday, April 1st, 2019. We will be preparing the soil for the next lottery winner at that time.
